








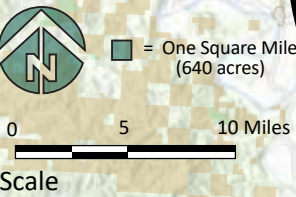
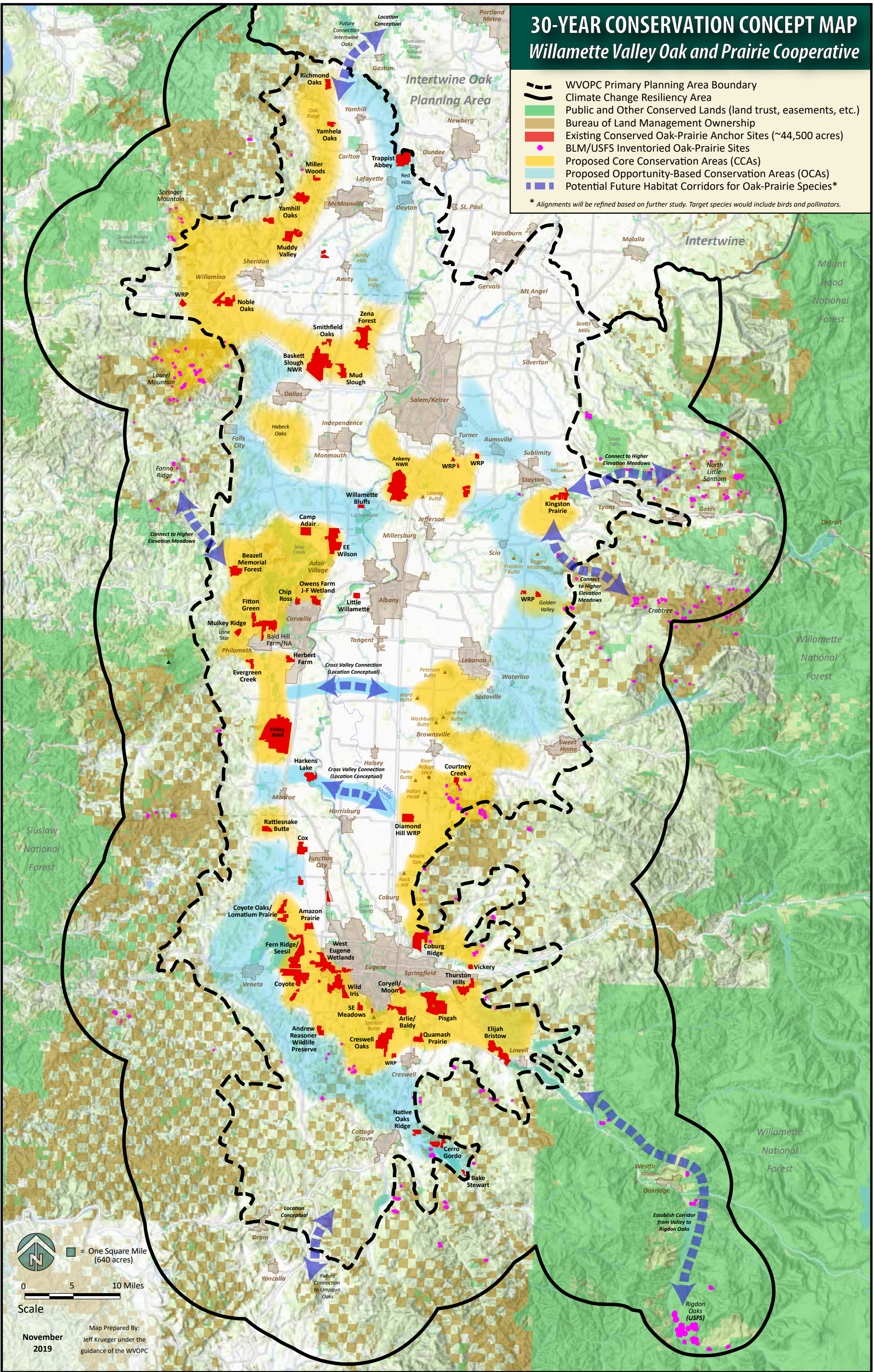


30-YEAR CONSERVATION CONCEPT MAP
