## **Investment Priorities and Impact Opportunities**

### ***1. Ecosystem Protection***

**Investment Opportunity:** \$102.1 million

**Impact:** Permanently secure 10,200 acres of oak and prairie habitat through conservation easements and land acquisition, preserving vital ecosystems and ensuring sustainable stewardship practices.

**Your Contribution:** As an individual funder, you can help tribes, land trusts, NGOs, and others protect properties by funding conservation easements or supporting land acquisition projects. Your investment will directly enable communities to conserve critical habitats and balance ecological needs with economic viability.

### ***2. Ecosystem Restoration***

**Investment Opportunity:** \$180 million

**Impact:** Restore 60,000 acres through conifer removal, fuels reduction, prescribed fire, understory planting, and invasive species control, leading to increased biodiversity, reduced wildfire risks, and enhanced carbon sequestration.

**Your Contribution:** Fund hands-on restoration efforts, such as forest health thinning, fuels reduction in the urban-wildland interface, invasive species removal, or prescribed fire implementation, or invest in innovative approaches like restoration monitoring technology to ensure long-term success.

### ***3. Community and Capacity Building***

**Investment Opportunity:** \$17.2 million

**Impact:** Develop a skilled restoration workforce, create local jobs, and engage communities in conservation, ensuring a robust restoration supply chain and community support for long-term ecosystem stewardship.

**Your Contribution:** Create jobs and invest in workforce training programs, partnership capacity, or community outreach initiatives that empower individuals and communities to participate in conservation work, ensuring sustainable outcomes and local economic growth.

### ***4. Species Recovery***

**Investment Opportunity:** \$4.9 million

**Impact:** Deliver targeted recovery efforts for imperiled species, including habitat management and research, leading to increased populations of key species such as streaked horned larks and Fender's blue butterflies.
